CânSing, managed by CaST Cymru, is now in its fifth year and targets pupils in Years 5, 6 and 7 by offering training, bespoke support and curriculum-linked resources to encourage and support the teaching of singing across Wales.

The support for this programme is clear, this is our fourth National CânSing Day and there were CânSing Day events happening all over Wales and the six CânSing animateurs (vocal coaches) were very busy attending events in Wrexham, Denbighshire, Conwy, Swansea, RCT and Pembrokeshire.

Many teachers chose to work with other nearby schools and brought pupils together to unite voices by using the CânSing resources which are available on the dedicated website (www.cansing.org.uk).

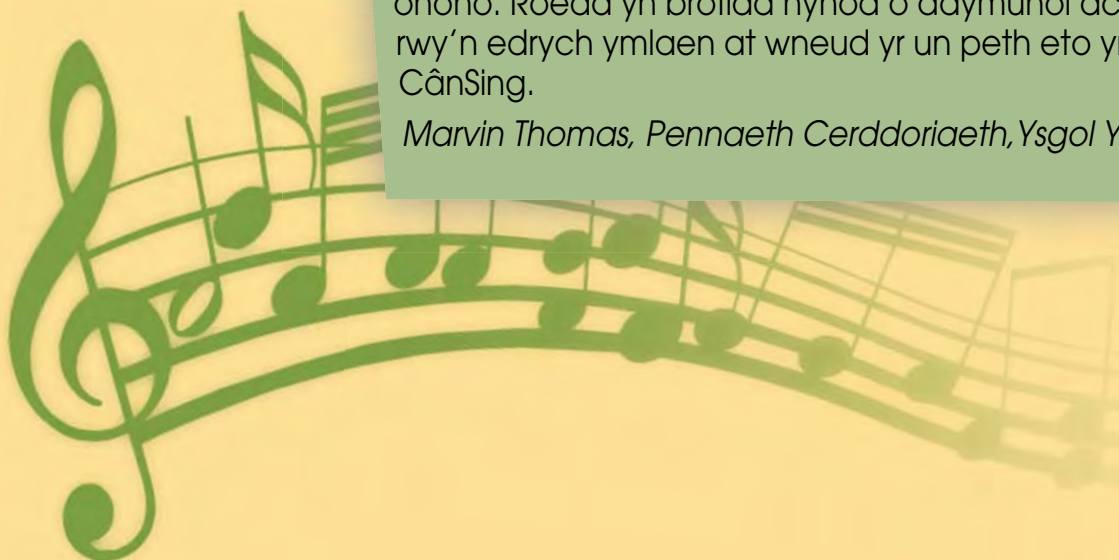

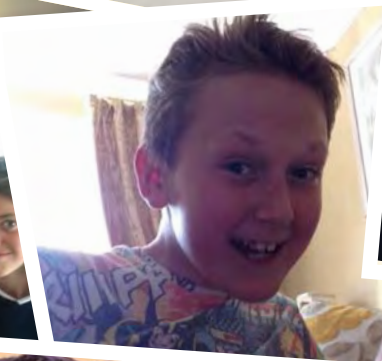
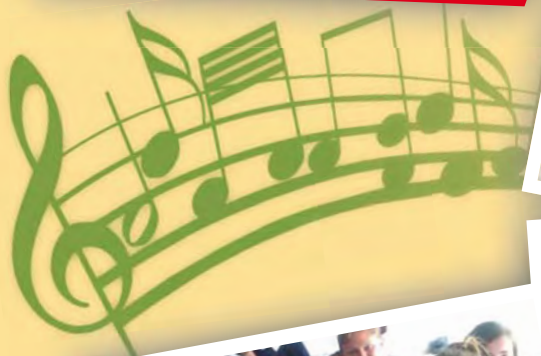

The National Children's Choir of Great Britain is working with the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama in a new partnership. The choir, which was founded in 1998, runs two residential courses every year in the Easter and Summer holidays; these courses give talented children the opportunity to sing together and make music of an outstandingly high standard. The repertoire is very varied, ranging from madrigals and Purcell to Chilcott and Bart. NCCGB tours regularly, most recently in Italy in 2012, and will sing in Northern Spain in 2016.

In addition to their courses, NCCGB is starting a workshop programme throughout the UK, for all children who love to sing. The first workshop will be at RWCMD on Sunday 12th October 2014, for children from school years 4 to 7. NCCGB conductors will lead the event and there will also be an opportunity to audition for entry into the choir in 2015. The cost of the workshop will be £5 per child, and the audition fee is £5 extra.
